<u>SITE SPECIFIC</u> → accident → injury	The 'employee' leading the tour will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Take due consideration of the ground conditions at the time of the visit. <input type="checkbox"/> Take due consideration of site location at the time of the visit. <input type="checkbox"/> Brief all participants on appropriate precautions to take whilst visiting the site, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be careful of any moving vehicles in the vicinity of the site. • Be careful when walking across uneven ground. • Keeping a safe distance from the edges of cliffs, walls, bridges etc. • Being careful around water. • Do not climb on walls, memorials, monuments, buildings, ruins or other potential hazardous parts of the site. • Do not climb over or circumnavigate barriers and/or fences as they are there to protect the visitor as well as preserve the site. <input type="checkbox"/>
