On the 6 June 1944, the greatest seaborne invasion the world has ever known took place on the Calvados Coast of Normandy, France.

1,900 allied transport aircraft and glides carried the 23,400 American, British, and Canadian paratroopers who mounted the airborne assault.


6,939 vessels of all shapes and sizes transported the 132,715 soldiers who landed on the five invasion beaches.

Of these 156,115 Allied soldiers, 8,443 would become casualties.

It was the beginning of the end of the Second World War in Northwest Europe, the beginning of the advance across Europe and into Germany that would last 332 days and end with the unconditional surrender of Nazi German.

It was D-Day, that day of days that changed the course of history.
